

NATS adopts a new Code of Ethics -

The NATS Code of Ethics has been updated to address increased societal focus on professional relationships and to serve as a modern guide to our membership.

A special message to Indiana NATS Chapter Members:

In order to address the increased societal focus on discouraging inappropriate, non-consensual interaction between people in a professional relationship, the NATS Ethics Committee reviewed the NATS Code of Ethics <https://www.nats.org/code-of-ethics.html> during the Fall of 2017 and Spring of 2018 and suggested needed changes so that the Code will serve as a modern guide to our membership.

The revised version was reviewed by NATS legal counsel and approved by the Board of Directors in June. The new Code of Ethics <https://www.nats.org/code-of-ethics.html> in its final form is posted on the NATS website along with updated pages on ethics and a guide for addressing such concerns using the process outlined in our bylaws.

The new Code of Ethics policy will also be included in the Fall 2018 *Inter Nos*, coming soon.
